It is the largest state in the US and the least densely populated. Alaska was first colonized in the 17<sup>th</sup> century by Russia. However, in 1867 it was bought by the United States for 7,2 million dollars. **B.** About half the population of Alaska is white, the rest is mostly made up of American Indians, Alaskan Natives and Asians. Over 5% of the population of Alaska speak one of the 20 native languages. Most of the people living in Alaska are Christian and since there are still a lot of Russian immigrants living in Alaska there has been an increasing number of Russian Orthodox churches appearing, the first one having been built in 1795.
